WHAT IS PIGMENTED LESIONS/SUN SPOTS/ AGE SPOTS?

Pigmented lesions are areas of skin that have become discolored due to an increase in the amount of pigment cells in the area. These lesions can occur on any part of the body and can vary in color, size, and shape. They can be caused by age, sun exposure, genetics, hormones, or other medical conditions. Most pigmented lesions are harmless, but they should be checked to rule out melanoma.

These skin spots and growths are caused by melanocyte cells in the skin. Melanocytes are the cells that produce melanin, the substance that gives color (pigment) to the skin. Common pigmented lesions include: Age spots/Sun Spots/Liver Spots

HOW DOES IT WORK?

When laser treatment is used to treat pigmentation, the light from the laser targets the pigment in the skin and breaks it down into smaller fragments. These particles are then absorbed and eliminated from the body. The laser is very precise, targeting the pigmentation precisely, without affecting any of the healthy surrounding tissue. The entire process involves using, short, powerful bursts of light energy to heat the pigmented areas of skin, breaking up the pigmentation and eliminating it naturally from the body. This is why laser treatment is an effective and safe way to reduce pigmentation and improve the overall appearance of the skin.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT DURING THE TREATMENT?

During laser age spot or sun spot removal, you can expect the affected area to be treated with a laser to break up the pigmentation of the spots. Depending on the size, shape, and number of spots, the laser energy can be adjusted to target the area with precision. The laser beam is typically cooled simultaneously to minimize discomfort. After treatment, the area may be slightly red and swollen and will usually heal within a few days.

AFTER THE TREATMENT

The purple/red colour will generally fade within 12 hours but the darker pigment over the area treated can remain for up to 10 days. This will gradually flake away and leave fresher skin with reduced pigmentation behind. Do not pick and scratch treated area. It may appear as a dry skin patch and sometimes a scab will form over the treated area. There will be some redness where you have been treated. The skin will also be a little dry and require moisturising, sometimes the skin gently peels – again this depends on the treatment regime your somatologist decide on with you. You will be advised to use a sunscreen factor 50 for a minimum of 2 weeks before and after treatment. If you do not continue to use sunscreen then you are going to expose your skin to the risk of further sun damage.

HOW MANY SESSIONS

The treatment usually requires 3 to 5 sessions, depending on the severity of the spots, and the healing time is very short.
